As I look back, God did some big things in 2021:

- We brought on another full-time staff position
- We had our biggest financial giving year ever
- We celebrated more baptisms (13) this year than any other year prior
- We had our largest attended Sunday morning worship service (269 people) this year
- Our student ministry grew by over 50%
- We hosted more Community Groups the last semester of the year than any semester before
